BYLAW NO. 696

Being a bylaw to amend the Corporation of the Village of Harrison Hot Springs Traffic Bylaw

WHEREAS: the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Harrison Hot Springs deems it advisable to amend the Traffic Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE: the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Harrison Hot Springs HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Bylaw 378 is hereby amended by inserting the following subsection in Section IV:
"A(2)(f) No driver of any commercial vehicle exceeding 6.1 metres in length or a gross weight of 5,500 kg. shall, between the hours of 9:00 p.m. of any day and 6:00 a.m. of the following day, park such vehicle on a Village street or byway."
2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Traffic Amendment Bylaw No. 696, 1997."
