BYLAW NO. 804, 2004

A Bylaw to amend Traffic By-law No. 378, 1982

Council of the Corporation of the Village of Harrison Hot Springs, in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

CITATION

1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Traffic Amendment Bylaw No. 804, 2004".

AMENDMENTS

2. Traffic By-law No. 378, 1982 is hereby amended, as follows:
 - (a) the following is added as subsection 5 of Section VI (Pedestrian Regulations):
 5. Unless authorized by a permit issued under this bylaw or a Street Event Permit issued under the Village of Harrison Springs Street Event Bylaw No.802, 2004, no person shall walk, run or otherwise proceed along a roadway of a highway if there is a sidewalk that is reasonably passable on either or both sides of the highway. If there is no sidewalk, a pedestrian must walk, run or proceed only on the extreme left side of the roadway or the shoulder of the highway, facing traffic approaching from the opposite direction.

READ A THIRD TIME this seventeenth day of February, 2004.
