PROPERTY TAXES 2009

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Payment **MUST** be received at the Village Office before **4:30 P.M. FRIDAY July 31, 2009** to avoid a 10% penalty.
- Sewer and Water user fees are also subject to 10% penalty.
- Please read **BOTH** sides of your tax notice carefully.
- Post marks **NOT** accepted as proof of payment.

Homeowner Grants:



- If you are eligible for the homeowner grant, please complete the application on the reverse side of the bottom portion of your tax notice and return to the Village Office by **4:30P.M. FRIDAY July 31, 2009.**
- If you do not apply for your homeowner grant on or before **July 31, 2009** the amount of your grant will be subject to a **10% PENALTY.**
- Claiming of the home owner grant is not dependent on payment of taxes and may be applied for anytime prior to the tax deadline to avoid a penalty.
- If your mortgage company is paying on your behalf, please ensure you remit your homeowner grant application to our office prior to the **July 31, 2009** deadline.

Payment Methods:

- **POST DATED CHEQUES** up to **July 31, 2009** are acceptable and encouraged.
- By mail - complete the homeowner grant application and return it with your payment.
- Payments may be made at any Prospera Credit Union. Please allow three (3) business days for processing.
- Online Banking (through Credit Unions)- Please allow three business days for processing.
- Please include the bottom portion of the tax notice with your remittance.
- In person at the Village Office during Office Hours (8:30 a.m. – Noon and 1:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.)
- Payments by cash, cheque and Interac.
- Property taxes **cannot** be paid with Visa, or Master Card.

Tax Deferral Plans:
