

Once I'm connected to the municipal water system, how much will my water utility bill be?

Your utility bill will see two water charges.

- Water Service User Fee – This fee is primarily used for the operating cost of the water system. The fees depend on the residential type as shown in the table below:

Residential	Quarterly	Annual
Single Family	\$70.00	\$280.00
Duplex (per unit)	\$70.00	\$280.00
Secondary Suite	\$30.00	\$140.00
Swimming Pool	\$70.00	\$280.00

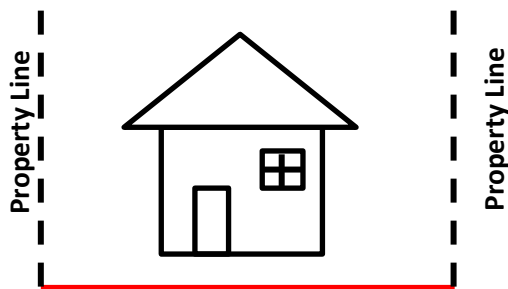
- Water Service Utility Fee – This fee is primarily used for capital replacement of infrastructure.

This fee is dependent on two variables:

- Length of the property that abuts the water distribution main.
- Water rate – which is the fee per metre.

Water Rate	Minimum	Maximum
\$11.14/metre	18 metres	30 metres

- Please see the example below:



Length of the property that abuts the water distribution main
Example: 12 metres

Water Distribution Main

Length of property that abuts the water distribution main
X
\$11.14/metre

In this example the property that abuts the water distribution main is only 12 metres in length; therefore, the calculation must use the minimum metre amount (18 metres) as indicated in the table above.

$$18 \text{ metres} \times \$11.14/\text{metre} = \$200.52 \text{ annually}$$

or

$$= \$50.13 \text{ quarterly}$$

If the property measured 21.5 metres then this length would be multiplied by the water rate.
(21.5 metres x \$11.14/metre = \$239.51)
