RTIC-BC August Highlights

Worthy of Note

Vancouver Police Department Staff Sergeant Terry Yung has joined RTIC-BC as the unit Operations NCO. Terry replaces RCMP Staff Sergeant (now Inspector) Kathy Furgason.

MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL Extortion-Kidnapping

RTIC-BC is now compiling and coordinating information related to a series of Extortions/Kidnappings involving Asian victims in multiple jurisdictions. This information has been used to guide investigators from several police agencies.

BURNABY RCMP Computer Theft

RTIC-BC provided assistance to Burnaby RCMP investigators, relating to a series of thefts, and use of a stolen debit card. BC Corrections Services intelligence officer, seconded to RTIC-BC, immediately identified the suspect from jail records.

DELTA POLICE DEPARTMENT Commercial Break-In and Theft

RTIC-BC assisted Delta PD members investigating a series of Commercial B&E's and related thefts. A suspect vehicle appearing in multiple security videos was of a distinctive year and style. RTIC-BC research identified a local criminal individual as an owner of a matching vehicle. This information prompted surveillance of this suspect, which is ongoing.

MISSION RCMP Firearm Seizure

RTIC-BC assisted Mission RCMP members in preparing a search warrant to recover illegal firearm and ammunition. Mission RCMP members indicated that RTIC-BC information was of significant assistance to their successful warrant application.
