Fire safety and prevention is always of the upmost importance. During these increasingly hot, dry summer months it is increasingly more critical.

The Harrison Hot Springs Fire Department is encouraging residents to be extra vigilant and ensure that fire safety is at the forefront. Residents and visitors need to be diligent if using any cooking or heating appliances with an open flame. An open flame must not exceed a 15 cm height limit with a maximum of a 20 lb cylinder. Never leave a cooking or heating appliance unattended.

Open burning is prohibited in the Village of Harrison Hot Springs. Please refer to Open Burning and Outdoor Fire Regulation Bylaw #1110 for further information. This bylaw regulates and prohibits any open burning. The use of fireworks and lanterns are also prohibited and residents and visitors are required to adhere to the bylaw or face enforcement penalties.

Should you witness open burning or the use of fireworks, during daytime hours, please call Bylaw Enforcement at 604-796-2171. After hours please call the Fire Department Duty Officer at 604-819-4944.
