ONLINE COUNCIL MEETINGS

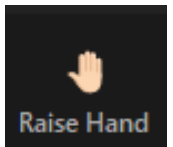

Joining a Meeting

- Click on the link that is provided on our website **OR** Open Zoom and enter the Meeting ID (provided on our website).
- You will be placed in a waiting room until the meeting begins.

Question Period

Question Period is held at the end of Regular Council Meetings. During this portion of the meeting you may indicate that you would like to ask a question (pertaining to agenda items only) by using the Raise Hand feature. This function may be shown on the video or participants panels.*



Viewing Etiquette

- Enter your name when you join the meeting.
- Remain on mute and do not interrupt Council discussion.
- Keep your camera turned off.
- Participants may be removed from the meeting if there are interruptions.
