SUBJECT: 2014 Age-friendly Community Planning and Project Grants

ISSUE:

As part of the UBCM grant application to fund an age-friendly community plan, a resolution from Council is required stating that the Village of Harrison Hot Springs support for the project and a willingness to provide overall grant management.

BACKGROUND:

UBCM in partnership with the Ministry of Health has committed to fund 25 grants for a total \$20,000.00 each for an age-friendly community planning study or project. Priority will be given to communities that have not yet completed an age-friendly plan. To date the Village of Harrison Hot Springs has not completed an age-friendly plan. If successful, the age-friendly plan will outline the current status of Harrison's aging population, methods to engage this segment of the population and how to support our aging population into the future.

As part of the grant application, a resolution from Council is required that indicates local government support for the age-friendly plan and a willingness to provide overall grant management. The age-friendly plan must be completed in 2014, and local government is not required to provide any matching funds.
