6. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

a. Communities in Bloom Committee- 2009

The Committee discussed the future of the Communities in Bloom Committee. The Chair expressed that he would like to see this committee continue but would like to see a representative from the Tourism Society and the Chamber of Commerce. It was also felt that a member of the Committee needs to be a liaison to the Chamber of Commerce and that person should attend the Chamber meetings.

The Committee briefly discussed some ideas for the hosting of the 2009 Communities in Bloom Award Conference. They felt that they would try and keep the typical information sessions on the Saturday morning to a minimum. They would like to see a session on the Miami River with some scientists, a boat tour to Echo Island and a possible panel of judges to explain some of the criteria that they use for judging communities. Everyone agreed that they did not want to do a bus tour.

The date for the 2009 Communities in Bloom Conference is September 17th, 2009 and Harrison is expecting approximately 100 participants. The Committee felt that they need to increase their numbers to accomplish all the work that will be required to put on the conference. They agreed that discussions on the planning would start in January.
