The working group which will consist of 7-9 residents will be chaired by the CAO and Michael Rosen will also attend these meetings. A member of this group will be responsible for the minutes of the meetings. The Working Group does not need to be as formal as a select committee. The Chair noted the changes that were made regarding this "select committee". The CAO stated that it was Councils decision to appoint a Work Group instead of a select committee. Members will now be selected from residents of the area who respond to the letter of interest which will be sent out by the Village office.
