



Declaration of State of Local Emergency ORDER

WHEREAS *two of the three pumps at the water treatment facility* within the jurisdiction of the *Village of Harrison Hot Springs* have failed;

AND WHEREAS the *failure of two of the three pumps* poses an existing or imminent threat to people and property as it impacts the availability of water for drinking and firefighting within the *Village of Harrison Hot Springs*;

AND WHEREAS this *water treatment facility pump* emergency requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to *Section 12 (1) of the Emergency Program Act (RS, 1996, Chap 111)* that a state of local emergency exists in the *Village of Harrison Hot Springs* due to the *failure of two of the three pumps at the water treatment facility* and the *resulting impact to the availability of water for drinking and firefighting*;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the *Village of Harrison Hot Springs*, its employees, servants and agents are empowered pursuant to *Section 13 (1) of the Emergency Program Act* to do all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency.

ORDERED by *Mayor Ed Wood* this date, *November 1, 2023*, to remain in force for seven days until *November 8, 2023* at midnight unless cancelled by the *Village of Harrison Hot Springs* or the Minister responsible.
