

## Declaration of State of Local Emergency ORDER

WHEREAS two of the three pumps at the water treatment facility within the jurisdiction of the Village of Harrison Hot Springs have failed;

AND WHEREAS the failure of two of the three pumps poses an existing or imminent threat to people and property as it impacts the availability of water for drinking and firefighting within the *Village of Harrison Hot Springs*;

AND WHEREAS this water treatment facility pump emergency requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

## NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the Emergency Program Act (RS, 1996, Chap 111) that a state of local emergency exists in the Village of Harrison Hot Springs due to the failure of two of the three pumps at the water treatment facility and the resulting impact to the availability of water for drinking and firefighting;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the *Village of Harrison Hot Springs*, its employees, servants and agents are empowered pursuant to *Section 13 (1) of the Emergency Program Act* to do all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency.

ORDERED by *Mayor Ed Wood* this date, *November 1, 2023*, to remain in force for seven days until *November 8, 2023* at midnight unless cancelled by *the Village of Harrison Hot Springs* or the Minister responsible.
