Instructions

2. If your application is received by **4:00 pm October 9, 2026** and filled out correctly, a mail ballot package will be sent to you as soon as the ballots are available.
3. You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot and documents are received by the Chief Election Officer **by October 17, 2026 before the close of voting at 8:00 pm.**

Resident and Non-Resident Property Electors

A **resident elector** is an eligible elector who lives in Harrison Hot Springs.

A **non-resident property elector** is an eligible elector who owns real property in Harrison Hot Springs but resides elsewhere in BC.

and request that I receive a ballot to vote by mail, under the provisions of the *Local Government Act* section 110 in the general local election on October 17, 2026.

I hereby declare that I am:

- ☐ 18 years of age or older on general voting day – October 17, 2026; and
- ☐ a Canadian citizen; and
- ☐ a resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the day of voter registration; and
- ☐ not disqualified by law from voting in a general local election or otherwise disqualified by law; and

- ☐ a resident of the municipality; **OR**
- ☐ a non-resident owner of real property in the municipality for at least 30 days immediately before the day of voter registration.

Identification

Resident electors must produce or provide copies of **two (2) pieces of identification** that prove residency and identity (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary.

Non-resident property electors must produce or provide copies of **two (2) pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property (e.g. Property Tax Notice, Land Title Registration or BC Assessment Notice), and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from a majority of the registered owners.

Acceptable Identification – Two (2) Pieces Required

If submitting this application **in person**, please bring two pieces of acceptable identification. If submitting this application **by mail**, please contact our office. Do not send copies of identification by mail. If submitting this application **by email**, please attach copies and check below which pieces of identification you are providing:
